Warehouse Café offers Wi-Fi and joins the RECHARGE Scheme™.

The Warehouse Café in Shenton Park is excited to announce they now have Wi-Fi available to customers. This addition will allow patrons to conduct work from within the café as well as adding to the ease of hosting events and meetings in the café's rooms for hire. The password can be acquired from the barista when purchasing your daily cup of coffee or tea, or when you book the meeting room for an event.

The Warehouse Café is an activity for social benefit within UnitingCare West. It provides opportunities for people living with disabilities to increase their skills in a business setting.

Further to this, the café is now a part of the RECHARGE Scheme™. This includes having a designated area within the café for people to safely recharge their electric mobility scooter or wheelchair, free of charge. The aim of this Australia wide scheme is to reduce the isolation often experienced by those who use electronic transport due to the fear that they could run out of battery whilst travelling around their local area. The Warehouse Café is pleased to be one of four locations within the Subiaco area that have signed up for the program.
